Board Meeting Highlights - 8/22/2015

The Board of the TV Woodworkers Club met on August 22. Eighteen members were present. The following items were discussed.

Club members have engaged in 32 service projects year-to-date; two of these are still in progress.

Treasurer Rick Mannarino reported \$2631.17 in the General Fund, \$105.00 in the Toys for Tots fund, and \$2400.00 in the Kiln Amortization fund.

The Club has been promised several trees scheduled to be cut down soon, including a pecan tree in Sweetwater, a white oak in Tellico Village, and several golf course

trees. September 8, 15, and 22 have been reserved for possible wood cutting days.

There are currently eight Toys for Tots teams formed with 53 members in total, and nine individuals building toys. In addition, there are four members waiting to join a team.

Make a photo copy of your pattern

Place the ink side down on the material you want the pattern on

Iron the copy to reactivate the ink and effect the transfer
