

Wood turners, wanna be turners, and those that may want to consider turning.

13 Participants with 3 chainsaws running.

The rest of the volunteers queued up the wood on the concrete pad for waxing and then the sale. We arranged to have 3 separate cutting areas with helpers at each station.



Dick Hoffmann brought his chainsaw cutting stand and mentored a few members with the use of the chainsaw.

Total income from this cutting was \$109. Estimated use of 1.5 gallons / \$50 of Anchorseal. Pricing was set with examples of half logs: small @ \$1, medium @ \$2, large @\$3 and the two big cherry crotch pieces at \$5 each. Small diameter "logs" were free. Unsold half logs were placed in the barn to be sold at the next kiln unload, free logs were placed to the left of the cutting pad.
